Considers S. 721, to amend Truth in Lending Act to authorize Federal Reserve Board to regulate unsolicited credit card issuance, and limit credit card liability when used by unauthorized persons. Focuses on theft of unsolicited credit cards from mails. Considers. H.R. 15 and related H.R. 10745, to authorize Federal Home Loan Bank Board to charter and supervise mutual savings banks. H.R. 3547, to amend Home Owners' Loan Act of 1933 to allow issuance of guaranteed stock by Federal savings and loan associations to raise capital. H.R. 11139, to establish a more convenient system of Federal savings associations to accommodate public needs and to increase savings. Considers H.R. 12219 and identical bills, to authorize U.S. membership in the Asian Development Bank. Considers S. 805, to authorize U.S. to participate in an increase in resources of the fund for special operations of Inter-American Development Bank. Includes special report of National Advisory Council on International Monetary and Financial Problems (p. 3-60) supporting the increase. Considers legislation to revise limitations on real estate loans made by national banks; to authorize banks to form bank service corporations to perform automated clerical, accounting, statistical and other similar bank services; to transfer from Federal Reserve Board to Comptroller of the Currency authority over trust powers of national banks; and to permit the national bank resulting from a conversion from a state bank to retain its branches. Considers H.R. 11508, to authorize the Federal Home Loan Bank Board to review and issue charters for new mutual savings banks and to authorize the Federal Savings and Loan Insurance Corp. to insure these new banks and to change its title to the Federal Savings Insurance Corp.
